Introduction

The "Syrian Dialogue Centre - SDC" is a Syrian civil society organization which aims to inspirit and activate the dialogue regarding important issues to the Syrian people. Seeking to strengthen relations, enhance cooperation and coordination between Syrians. SDC started its work through the first consultative symposium regarding Syrian affairs in the first quarter of the year 1435H -2015 AD. That was followed by four consultative symposiums during the years of 1435H -2015 to 1436H -2016 when SDC establishment has been announced as a response to the demands of the broad spectrum of active figures and institutions involved in the previous symposiums during the year of 2016. SDC has two programs, **the Political Dialogue Program** and **the society Dialogue Program**.

Vision

To be a trustworthy home for Syrian dialogue and a pioneering model for promoting a culture of dialogue.

Mission

To initiate constructive dialogue that enables the Syrians to find practical solutions to face their common challenges, achieving integration, coexistence and rationalization of national decision-making.

Values

- Professionalism in the tools of dialogue and its ethics commitment .A professional commitment to the ethics, tools, and processes of dialogue
- Excellence in identifying and facing challenges
- Prioritizing the national interest over any factious or external affiliation

THE "POLITICAL DIALOGUE PROGRAM"

The "political dialogue program" aims to promote the culture of dialogue and confidence-building between Syrian Revolutionary and Opposition Forces. Where SDC seeks to contribute in achieving consensus regarding strategic political issues. It also tries to bring the views of them closer together in order to come out with common positions regarding the political developments. The "Political Dialogue Program" includes three "dialogue routes" and a training route as following:

- **1 The "Coexistence" dialogue route**: It aims to promote and build the general national dialogue.
- **2 The "Cohesion" dialogue route**: It is intended to promote dialogue between specific and similar categories and specializations.
- **3** The "Detector" dialogue route: a periodic symposium aims to discover the hidden aspects of political issues, and then implementing dialogue in order to come out with common and general recommendations regarding them. Therefore, SDC works on preparing a dialogue platform which brings together experts and specialists from interested parties, researchers and politicians in order to discuss the latest developments in the political arena. The "Detector dialogue route" is being implemented in partnership with "Strategy watch" and "Omran Centre for Strategic Studies", where the partner centres prepare highly professional "position assessment papers" to study the issues supposed to be discussed in the "Detector dialogue route" in order to enrich the debate in the symposiums and come up with more accurate and comprehensive insights.

THE SOCIETY DIALOGUE PROGRAM

The Society Dialogue Program aims to take the initiative in order to restore the vitality and the wellbeing of the Syrian society after decades of the tyranny of authority in general. Hence, in particular, it aims to discuss the community reactions caused by the Syrian Revolution in order to contribute in reforming what can be reformed. It also aims to enhance the culture of society work, and to contribute in strengthening of society, opening prospects for it, mobilizing its latent self-potential, and activating of institutions or individuals so that they will be self - motivated. Furthermore, it works to create a culture that highly appreciates the value of the community with consolidation of its centralization, and trusts its capacity and energies.

The social dialogue program includes two dialogue routes and a training route as following:

- **1** "Building" route dialogue: SDC disseminates the thought and the culture of the society and promotes the centrality of society and the standards of its health and vitality.
- **2** "**Reform**" route dialogue: SDC practically monitors the urgent societal phenomenons resulting from the repercussions of the Revolution, the legacy of "Al Baath party" rule, or the phenomenons expected to occur which need to be raised and highlighted via activating appropriate dialogue activities between concerned stakeholders.
- 3 **Route (training):** consists of two aspects, the first is a skilful aspect that cares about the skills support the work of SDC in general. And the second is an objective aspect deals with topics that enhance the capabilities of the social interlocutors.

Activities of 2017

In the year of 2017, the Syrian Dialogue Centre held 16 events in addition to participating in the implementation of the "National Dialogue" project, the activities were distributed between the political dialogue program and the social dialogue program, as follows:

" The National Dialogue" project

The "National Dialogue" project is one of the "Coexistence route" projects under the political dialogue program of SDC. The project aims to enhance and build the national dialogue according to organized and studied steps depending on study the common points / issues between different parties and seeking to develop them, and searching for disputed points and studying the mechanism of their management and the coexistence with them.



Project Objective:

The project aims to build objective consensus between the various components of Syrian Revolutionary and Opposition Forces in order to agree on the foundations of the new social contract between the Syrians.

The implementing entities: The Syrian Dialogue Centre (SDC) and "civilians for justice and peace" organization.

The phases that have been implemented in the project:

SDC has conducted a theoretical research study that examined and analysed the political discourses / ideologies of 62 bodies and entities belong to Syrian Revolutionary and Opposition Forces in various disciplines: political, military and civilian, regarding 47 topics which represent the basis of the expected social contract whilst "civilians for justice and peace" organization has conducted a survey included 1700 guestionnaires, consequently, the two studies were combined into a summary of their results.



The project and the related studies were presented to the various forces, parties and institutions in the field. The majority of the forces and institutions have commended the exerted effort in the project and gave their different recommendations for follow-up.

Duration of implementing the two previous phases:

The two previous mentioned phases were implemented within around 10 months. Notably, the project will continue in 2018 via implementing detailed dialogue workshops, which will hopefully lead to broad consensus and participatory mechanisms in building the desired Syrian future.
